 - Global and regional linguistic epicentres, the contexts in which linguistic influence is exercised
 - Hansard/parliamentary records as diachronic corpora, their value as sources of spoken and written data on colonial and post-colonial Englishes
 - Language policy and education in post-colonial countries of the Indo-Pacific
 - Cultural reflections of contact in language innovation and change
 - Comparative processes in the emergence of regional and functional varieties of English.
