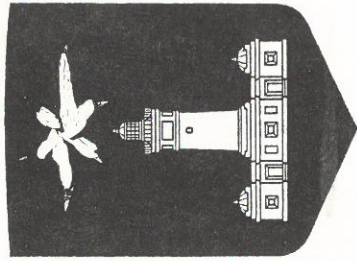

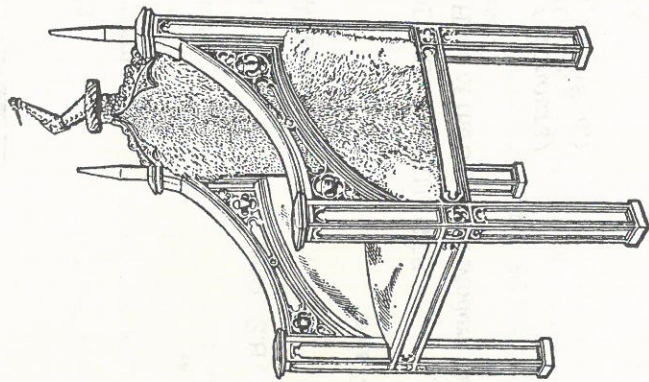

THE CHANCELLOR'S CHAIR

The Chancellor's Chair, which today is used for the first time in a formal ceremony, was made for Major-General Lachlan Macquarie during his term as Governor of New South Wales, 1809-1821. It is one of a pair of similar chairs believed to have been made and presented to Governor Macquarie by convicts, and subsequently passed down in the Macquarie family. The Chancellor's Chair was presented to the University in 1967 by Mrs J. E. Taylor of Edinburgh, a descendant of Lachlan Macquarie's younger brother, Colonel Charles Macquarie; the companion chair is now in the Museum of Applied Arts and Sciences, Sydney.

The chair is of Australian rosewood and is upholstered partly in kangaroo skin.
