



Analysis of reports lodged with Advocate Inappropriate/Unwanted behaviour reporting at Macquarie 1 July 2022 until 30 June 2023

Total number of reports lodged in this time period:

- 203 reports
 - 23% were lodged anonymously

Role of reporter at Macquarie*

Students	47%
Staff	33%
Other	19%

*Note that some identify as staff and students. Staff are over-represented, as reports are made by staff after contact with students about incidents.

*Person of concern is the individual whose behaviour is being reported

Person of concern (PoC)* demographics (where PoC is enrolled student) (total enrolled student POC calculation 115) *Person of concern is the individual whose behaviour is being reported

Report subject

Note that 1 report can have multiple subjects.

Bullying/harassment	*65% of all reports
- Face to face	63% of bullying/harassment reports
- Online bullying/harassment	46% of bullying/harassment reports
- Other	13% of bullying/harassment reports

*Categories are based on description of behaviour

Discrimination	*16% of all reports
- Race based discrimination	70% of discrimination reports
- Gender identity	12% of discrimination reports
- Sexual orientation	12% of discrimination reports
- Disability	6% of discrimination reports
- Other	12% of discrimination reports

Sexual misconduct	*35% of all reports
- Sexual harassment	73% of sexual misconduct reports
- Sexual assault	32% of sexual misconduct reports
- Stalking	17% of sexual misconduct reports
- Sexual exploitation	7% of sexual misconduct reports
 Posting/recording images without consent 	3% of sexual misconduct reports
- Other	11% of sexual misconduct reports
