

Partner Institutions

Please ask your students to submit their application through our <u>Online Application portal</u> and select Study Abroad (not Exchange). Students should indicate their sending institution in the application form.

While completing your student applications, please upload the following documents:

- Copy of student's passport
- Students transcripts: If your student is applying to a postgraduate program, postgraduate transcripts and undergraduate transcripts and degree awards are required.
- Proof of English proficiency:
 - Such as IELTS (Academic) Minimum requirement: 6.5 overall with 6.0 in each section. For a detailed list of other acceptable levels of English proficiency and English language package providers as approved by Macquarie University, please refer to our English Language Requirements page.

Unit selection

- Student to pre-select units based on our Course Handbook.
- Please keep in mind that several courses have prerequisites to ensure you are ready for study in that area. Check the prerequisites in the Course Handbook and make sure your course isn't listed as a restricted unit for Study Abroad students.

Academic Requirements	 Weighted Average Mark (WAM) Requirement: Non-Law students = 60 WAM Law students = 65 WAM
English Requirements	 The minimum English entry requirement that applies to most undergraduate or postgraduate courses is IELTS (Academic) – 6.5 overall with 6.0 in each section, or equivalent. Please note that some academic programs have specific entry requirements higher than the minimum. While selecting the units, you must consider the following: Units are available in the enrolled semesters: Session 1: February to June, OR Session 2: July – December Suitable to the students' level of study (UG = Undergraduate and PG = Postgraduate): Undergraduate level = 1000, 2000 and 3000 level units


