#### Eligibility criteria for participation in Faculty Board elections

Pursuant to Clause 4(f) of the <u>Faculty Board Terms of Reference</u>, at least one (1) continuing academic staff member is to be elected by and from the academic staff of each Department / School outlined above. These elections are to be held in accordance with Section 4 (Procedures for Election of Faculty Board) in the <u>Faculty Rules</u> which states that the staff members eligible to participate in the election and to be elected must be either:

- a) full-time continuing;
- b) part-time continuing; or
- c) fixed term for three or more years with fractional appointment of 50% and above.

A separate nomination form must be completed for each candidate. A nomination form must be:

- a) signed by two persons **qualified to vote for the position in the election** (i.e. academic staff from the **same** Department/ School as the nominee who also meet the criteria outlined above), one of whom is the proposer and one of whom is the seconder; and
- b) endorsed with, or accompanied by, the written consent of the candidate to his or her nomination.

The candidate draw will occur on Wednesday 8 May 2024 in The Chancellery, 19 Eastern Road (19ER). Further information will be provided to registered Scrutineers.
