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Table 2: Academic Senate resolved to endorse the functions identified below to be devolved to the Faculties, with an implementation date to be determined subject to the development of enabling resources. Functions have been revised to reflect the intent of Academic Senate and to apply that intent to the new curriculum architecture:

Approve changes to requisite requirements for units, including pre- and co-requisites and Not to Count for Credit With units.

Note: Recommended amendment expands scope to include pre- and co- requisite and corrects the reference to courses made in the initial resolution, which will also be required to delegation 5.5 in the Delegations Register

Approve the establishment or disestablishment of groupings of units as a major or specialisation.

Approve the establishment or disestablishment of groupings of units as a derived minor, if required and as specified by the Faculty Board.

Approve learning outcomes for a major or specialisation.

Recommend the establishment or disestablishment of groupings of units to Academic Senate for approval as a designated minor.

Recommend to Academic Senate the inclusion of a major, specialisation or designated minor in a course.

Recommend to Academic Senate amendments to the learning outcomes of a major or specialisation in a course.

Recommend to Academic Senate amendments to the number of credit points required to be completed at each unit level in a major or specialisation.

Recommend to Academic Senate the removal of majors, specialisations and designated minors from a course.

Approve the inclusion or exclusion of a specific unit as an elective unit within an option set of a course.

Approve amendments within the groupings of units in an approved major or specialisation, in accordance with the Curriculum Architecture Policy, including:

- a. the total number of essential units required
- b. the inclusion or exclusion of a specific unit as an essential unit
- c. the total number of credit points required to be completed.

Note: Changes to major or specialisation learning outcomes require approval by Academic Senate. **Note:** Recommended amendment demarcates the authority of the Faculty Board to recommend groupings of units as majors, specialisations and designated minors for approval by Academic Senate for inclusion in a course. The recommended amendment affirms Senate's intent that Faculty Boards have authority to manage units arrangements within approved majors and specialisations and must be considered in relation to the overarching directive for course changes to be linked to the outcome of annual or periodic review.

Approve amendments to course availability in a given year for commencing students or continuing students seeking to course transfer.
