Thank you for registering for updates on this exciting project.

We are currently busy analysing data from the surveys shared on our website, working through feedback from Educators and Approved Providers, Families and Other Key Stakeholders, identifying current strengths and suggested areas for updating in the frameworks. We are also analysing the children and young people's contributions through drawing and text collected by our leading practitioners who are a part of the Consortium.
