Plan for a 3:1 ratio. One hour contact time requires at least three hours of self-study

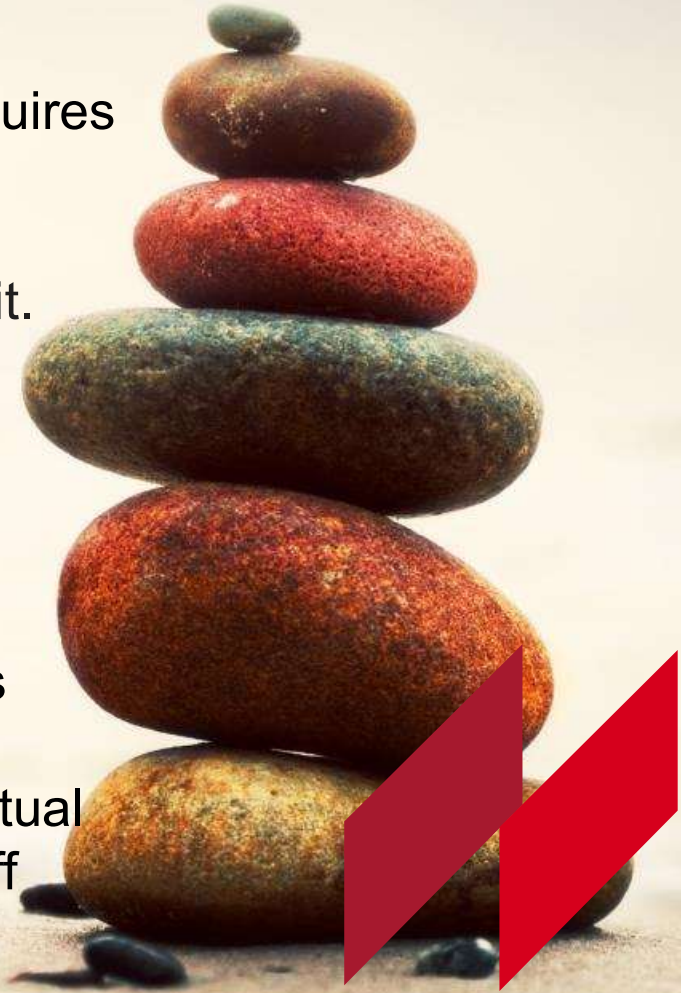
Approximately 15 hours per week for each unit.

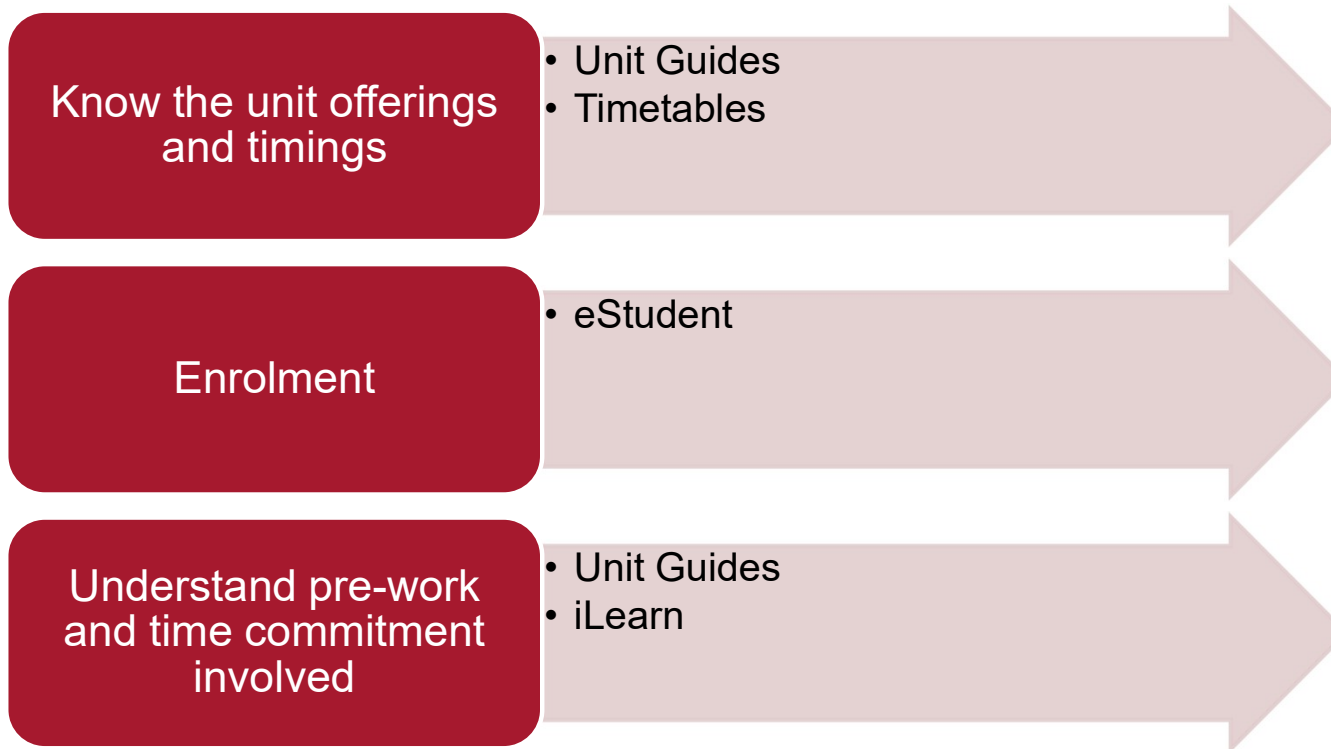



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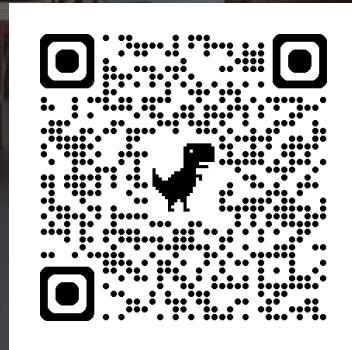
