

DISTINGUISHED FELLOW CHARTER

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Charter is to outline the role, responsibilities and expectations of Financial Integrity Hub (FIH) Distinguished Fellows. The Distinguished Fellowship recognises leading professionals and experts in financial integrity and cognate fields who have an established connection with the FIH and can contribute to its research, engagement and broader impact. Distinguished Fellows support the FIH in strengthening its profile as a globally recognised centre for research, collaboration and thought leadership on financial integrity.

ROLE

Distinguished Fellows are recognised experts who contribute their expertise, experience and professional networks to support the work and objectives of the FIH across government, industry and academia. Distinguished Fellows will have an established connection with the FIH and may contribute to its research, events, publications, stakeholder engagement and collaborative initiatives, as appropriate. The role is advisory and representational in nature and does not confer any governance or decision-making authority within the FIH.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Distinguished Fellows may contribute to the FIH by:

1. Enhancing the profile, visibility and credibility of the FIH through their expertise, professional networks and standing within their respective fields.
2. Supporting stakeholder engagement, strategic partnerships and collaborative initiatives across government, industry, academia and international organisations.
3. Facilitating domestic and international collaborations aimed at strengthening financial integrity frameworks and responses to financial crime.
4. Promoting and contributing to FIH research, publications, events and other initiatives within relevant professional, academic, regulatory and industry networks.
5. Contributing expertise and perspectives on emerging financial integrity, regulatory and financial crime challenges.
6. Facilitating opportunities for media engagement and identifying potential contributors to FIH publications, podcasts, events and public communications.
7. Supporting the FIH's research and educational activities, including through engagement with researchers, emerging scholars, students and future leaders in financial integrity.
8. Supporting initiatives that foster innovation, collaboration, diversity and the exchange of ideas across the financial integrity community.

FIH Distinguished Fellows Framework

- Distinguished Fellows shall be recognised professionals or experts in financial integrity or cognate fields, ordinarily with prior engagement or collaboration with the FIH.
- Appointments shall be made for a term determined in consultation with the FIH Director.
- Distinguished Fellows shall collectively bring diverse professional expertise, perspectives, backgrounds and networks to the FIH.
- Distinguished Fellows may be invited to participate in FIH events, research, publications, strategic discussions and other initiatives relevant to their expertise.
- Distinguished Fellows may be invited to participate in periodic meetings or strategic discussions with the FIH Director and Advisory Board.
