Peter Edwell is Senior Lecturer in the Department of History and Archaeology at Macquarie University, Sydney. He researches and teaches in the area of Late Antiquity with a special focus on the relationship between Rome and Sasanian Persia. Crises in political and religious leadership in the Roman Empire during periods of conflict with Persia are a particular focus of Peter's current research. As Deputy Director of the Australian Centre for Ancient Numismatic Studies he is also interested in how numismatics can be applied to the study of crisis and leadership.
