

PATRON'S CHARTER

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Charter is to outline the role, responsibilities, and duties of the Patron of the Financial Integrity Hub (FIH). The Patron serves as an esteemed figurehead who lends credibility, promotes the organisation's vision, and enhances its public profile. The Patron plays a key role in advocating for FIH's vision and engaging stakeholders but does not hold operational or executive responsibilities.

PATRON'S ROLE

The Patron is an eminent leader who provides advocacy, strategic counsel, and ambassadorial support to enhance the Financial Integrity Hub's profile, reputation, and cross-sectoral reach. Although the Patron does not participate in day-to-day governance or management, it acts as an advisor and supporter to the Director and the broader leadership team. The role is primarily external facing and symbolic, representing FIH's values and purpose to key stakeholders, partners, and the wider community.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PATRON

The key responsibilities of the Patron include the following:

1. Championing the vision and strategic objectives of the Financial Integrity Hub through public representation and advocacy.
2. Enhancing the reputation and profile of the FIH by acting as a distinguished ambassador at events, forums, and in communications.
3. Facilitating connections with key stakeholders, including government bodies, industry leaders, philanthropic partners, and academic institutions to support FIH's objectives.
4. Providing strategic counsel and informal advice to the Director and Advisory Board on matters relevant to the advancement of the FIH's purpose.
5. Supporting fundraising initiatives by lending credibility to campaigns, attending donor events, and endorsing key initiatives, as appropriate.
