### 1. **Minutes of the Meeting 21<sup>st</sup> February 2008 and Business Arising**

Minutes were adopted.

#### 1.1 Quality Enhancement Template

Prof Sachs underlined the Macquarie approach to quality – where quality is part of the Macquarie way of working and is not isolated to a central Quality Unit. This approach is based on the Quality Enhancement Framework <http://www.mq.edu.au/quality/>, and embodied in practices and values. This approach requires the development of templates for data collection purposes.

The circulated template has been trialled by the Library and the Office of the DVC (Research). It allows for the systematic capture of data for all Reviews that have been undertaken. Ms Newton tabled a modified template which was found to be more logical and evidence-based. The modified template was recommended for adoption and will be circulated. **Adopted**

### 2. **Management and Implementation**

#### 2.1 Faculty Representatives

Prof Sachs noted that the Macquarie approach to quality requires a network of quality contacts across faculties and administrative units. ## 2.3 Performance Portfolio Chap 2 Update

Ms Karen Davies will project manage Chapter 2 – Internationalisation. There will be a half day workshop on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April to agree a Macquarie definition of “internationalisation”, draft a format for the chapter and commence data collection.

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AUQA asked whether Macquarie wished to add any institution-specific areas under the “internationalisation” theme and it was decided to add volunteering – Volunteers Abroad and the Global Leadership Program.

### 2.4 Performance Portfolio Chap 3 Update

Work on the Research and Research Training chapter of the Performance Portfolio is being conflated with the Review of Macquarie’s Research Strategic Plan 2006-2008. Stakeholders are meeting fortnightly working on the outcomes of the 2006-2008 Plan, developing a 2009-2012 Plan and including Divisional-Faculty based planning.
