

Vote for your favourite projects

My Community Project funds projects in each NSW electorate to help improve the wellbeing of people and communities. Successful projects will be determined through a public vote and the projects that receive the most support will receive funding. Up to \$260,000 is available for each electorate. My Community Project is made possible by the NSW Generations Fund.







Step 7: If you have a log in account then log in then go to step 11

Create an account

Type in your email address

This is also your account username.

Password

Choose a password

Use 7 or more characters including at least 1 number and 1 letter. For a stronger password, include uppercase, lowercase and special characters like punctuation marks.

Confirm password

Retype your password

This must exactly match what you entered above.

Step 11: Voting for the project

You will be guided to the following page where you will be asked to enter your medicare card details. This is because NSW Government wants to ensure that you are the correct person who is voting, and that only one person can vote once.

Confirm your identity

Service NSW will confirm your identity using your **Medicare Card** details. This lets us check your identity and age, and ensures each person only votes once.

All fields are mandatory unless marked (optional)



Card colour

Green Blue Yellow

Scroll down. Enter the following details

Card colour

Green Blue Yellow

Medicare number

For example, 1234 5678 0

This is the 10 digit number on top of your card, please do not enter spaces

Expiry date

For example, 02/2021

Type in the format of MM/YYYY

Individual reference number

Select your reference number; for example 1

This is the 1 digit number before your name

Full name

Enter your full name

Enter your name exactly as it appears on your Medicare Card

Does the name on your Medicare card extend over multiple lines?

Date of birth

Enter your date of birth e.g., 01/01/1980

Type in the format of DD/MM/YYYY



Once you have selected a minimum of three projects a pop-up box will appear asking if you are ready to vote. If you are, click Vote Now



You will be directed to a page with your 3-5 top choices. When you are happy with the arrangement (select Use it or Lose it? Maximising your brain health as option 1!) then click Vote Now.



