Deputy vice-chancellor research co-funding request

Co-Funding

External funding schemes often require a commitment of funds, known as 'co-funding', from the University in addition to the funds requested through the scheme. Chief Investigators should first approach their Department and/or Faculty when seeking co-funding. Requests for co-funding will only be considered for proposals to **schemes that stipulate a requirement for institutional cash co-investment**.

Do not complete this form without first speaking to the Associate Dean Research within your Faculty.

Ensure that you have read the scheme Guidelines prior to completing your application.

Closing date: Co-Funding requests need to be submitted one (1) month prior to external funding body deadline.

Submission & Review Process:

To commence the application, please enter your project title below and click "Start Application".

Once you have completed all of the sections and mandatory questions, please click on the "Save and Submit" button. This will submit the application to your Faculty Research Office, who will let you know if anything additional is required. When complete, your application will proceed for assessment and you will be notified once an outcome is available.
