

Programs we offer

PREPARE FOR YOUR STUDIES

General English | 5-50 weeks

Our General English program caters for students from beginner to upper intermediate level. It develops the full range of communication skills, including reading, writing, listening, speaking, grammar and vocabulary in a blended learning environment for a range of everyday contexts for students who want to study general English or who are on a pathway to an academic English course.

Academic English | 5-20 weeks

Our Academic English program is designed for students from intermediate to advanced level. It aims to prepare students for academic study, introducing you to academic texts and the skills needed for success at university in Australia, while building language proficiency in a blended learning environment.

DIRECT ENTRY TO MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY

Our Direct Entry programs are well-known for their innovative approach, preparing students for their future studies by discipline. Each program has been based on the requirements and topics set by the Faculties. The content covers relevant text types and academic English skills for the discipline while continuing to develop your grammar and vocabulary in a blended learning environment. On completion of a Direct Entry program, you can enter your undergraduate or postgraduate degree without needing to sit an English proficiency test.

Business, Accounting and Economics | 10 weeks

This Direct Entry program is designed for students entering Macquarie University degrees in the Faculty of Business & Economics.

Human Sciences, Arts and Science | 10 weeks

This Direct Entry program is designed for students entering Macquarie University degrees in the Faculties of Human Sciences, Arts, Science & Engineering, and Medicine & Health Sciences.

Intensive Preparation Program | 5 weeks

This Direct Entry program is designed for students who are already very close to meeting the University's English entry requirements for their undergraduate or postgraduate degree program.

The program is designed for Australia Awards Scholarships students going to Macquarie University. It introduces students to the academic culture at the University and helps them develop the skills required for academic success.

DIRECT ENTRY TO MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY DIPLOMA AND FOUNDATION PROGRAMS

Macquarie University offers Diploma and Foundation pathway programs into Macquarie's undergraduate degrees. Our Direct Entry programs have been designed to develop the specific academic English skills needed while continuing to develop your English language proficiency. After you finish your ELC Direct Entry program, you can enter your Diploma or Foundation program without needing to sit an English proficiency test.

Foundation Direct Entry | 10 weeks

This program develops the language and academic skills needed to succeed in Foundation through engaging academic input as well as project work.

Diploma Direct Entry | 10 weeks

This program develops the language and academic skills needed to succeed at the Diploma level through engaging academic input as well as project work. This program is also designed to prepare students for Macquarie's Intensive Program, a two-term fast-track program into the first year of a Macquarie University undergraduate degree.
